4. Finance Report

- Current balances including salary & cash report our student centred funding is approximately \$4.9 million. Our starting budget is \$2.5 million.
- **Preliminary 2019 Budget for approval** to be shared with the Board after some changes are approved by the finance committee.
- Contributions & Charges 41% have paid, with 117 students paying it through the book list.

5. Principal update

- School Year start enrolments are at 559, one less than predicted. 20 classes with 65 staff. 3 new full time and 3 part time teaching appointments. Two part time EA appointments. At the beginning of the year we had an off-site development day for staff at Evedon Park based on team building and personality traits, tied in with the narrative theme for the term. Day 2 of staff development looked at the 'nuts and bolts' of the school's operations. The Back to School BBQ was successful with a pleasing turnout. Class Meetings have taken place by the end of Week 2. Staff will continue profiling Parent TV. Our Open Night is set for Week 10.
- **2018 Attendance** our average attendance for the year was 92%, just 1% above the state average. It is similar to the previous year.
- 2018 School Improvement Targets Candice shared and validated the targets
- Class liaison Parents parents who nominated received an email of thanks with a follow up email informing them of their appointment. Parents in each class will be

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- informed of their liaison and their role followed by the option of 'opting out' if they don't want their email details passed on to the liaison.
- Communication Facebook & Campaign Monitor the primary focus is whole school communication with currently 350 followers. The school is aware that there are glitches with Campaign Monitor and are working on them.
